In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY**, **JULY 18**, **2017**, upon the application of **EBR LOUISIANA**, **LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the Frio Zone, Reservoir A, in the Northeast Iowa Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana.

- 1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Frio Zone, Reservoir A.
- 2. To create a drilling and production unit for the exploration and production of gas and condensate from the Frio Zone such proposed unit being shown on the plat submitted with the application, being designated F RA SUA.
- 3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis.
- 4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoirs by Supplemental Order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such a reclassification be warranted based on evidence furnished to the Commissioner of Conservation.
- 5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Frio Zone is hereby defined as that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the electric log depths of 8,970' and 11,950' in the Magnolia Petroleum Company-Powell Lumber Co. No. C-1 Well (SN 48350), located in Section 31, Township 8 South, Range 6 West. The Frio Zone has been previously defined and adopted under Office of Conservation Order No. 39-X, effective August 19, 2008, in the Magnolia Petroleum Company-Powell Lumber Co. No. C-1 Well located in Section 31, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, as the stratigraphic interval encountered between the depths of 8,970' and 11,950' (electrical log measurements).

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in Baton Rouge and Lafayette, Louisiana.
